

AMATS 2018 Bike & Pedestrian Count Program Jan 1 – June 30, 2018

AMATS has completed **7** bicycle and pedestrian locations from Jan.1 – June 30, 2018. This is the **second** year utilizing the *MioVision* Camera. All of these counts were within the **Akron area**.

The City of Akron launched “*Great Streets Akron*” in early 2018 that targets 10 neighborhood business districts. AMATS partnered with the City in setting up bicycle and pedestrian counts with the MioVision Camera. **Five** Great Streets have been counted up to June 30, 2018.

Most of the bicycle and pedestrian locations were prioritized based on demographics and land use in mostly urban settings, proximity to retail, business and University areas. Locations were also chosen where bike lanes already exist in order to develop exposure rates.

The following count times and locations were completed in the first half of 2018:

Akron

- W Market St/Portage Path 5.2.18
- E Exchange St/Main St 5.7.18

Great Streets Akron

- West Hill – W Market St/Valley St 5.22.18
- North Hill – N Main St/Cuyahoga Falls Ave 5.23.18
- Maple Valley – Hawkins Ave/Copley Rd 5.3.18
- Middlebury – Market St/Arlington St 5.31.18
- Wallhaven – Hawkins Ave/Exchange/W Market 6.6.18
