Carbon Reduction funds (CRP) can be used for projects which are proven to lower carbon emissions. Projects can include roundabouts, traffic flow improvements, transit improvements and bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure. CRP funds can be used on any functionally classified road from urban minor collector/rural major collector or higher.

CRP funds can be used for right of way and construction.

Local legislation showing support of local match due with application. Exceptions may be granted on a case by case basis.

Maximum CRP project request is \$2,000,000.

Minimum local match is 20%

<p><u>Project Delays</u> – projects that are delayed or cancelled will be re-evaluated based on the following principles:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. If a project is delayed due to the lack of programmed federal funds, the project will be rescheduled as soon as funds become available. b. If a project is delayed due to the project sponsor, the project may be cancelled or rescheduled at a later time so as not to impact or jeopardize other projects that have met their schedules. <p><u>Major Changes to Project Funding</u> – Projects which have already received federal CRP funds through AMATS are not eligible to apply for additional CRP funds through AMATS' normal application cycle. If additional funding for a project is necessary a request must be made to the AMATS Staff and will be reviewed by the TAC TIP Subcommittee, TAC and Policy Committee, with the Policy Committee having final decision-making authority.</p>
