The Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Greater Akron Area. The 2015 AMATS Demographic Profile was designed to be a Census-based snapshot of the area, making quickly available some of the most frequently requested characteristics of the AMATS Area. There are four general categories in which the characteristics can be grouped:

2. Income
3. Household Characteristics
4. Housing

All of the information used to generate these maps came from the 2013 American Community Survey (5-Year Estimates) and is available for viewing/downloading at factfinder.census.gov.

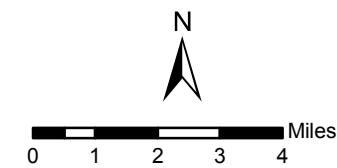
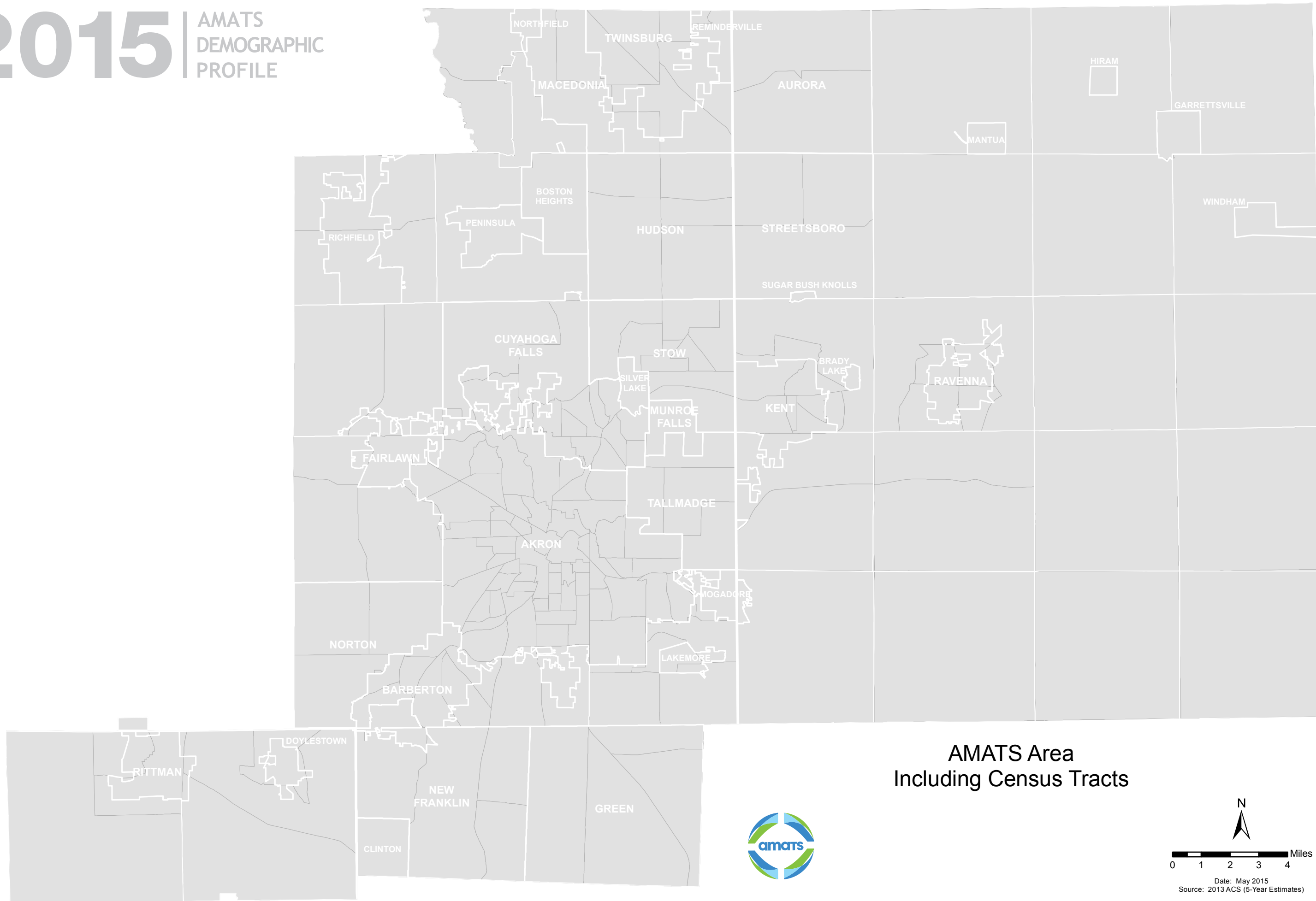

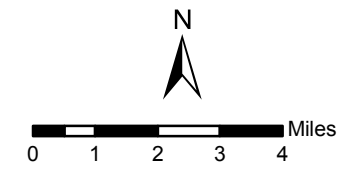
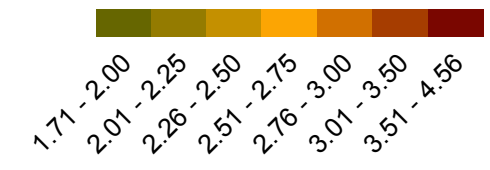
Median Household Income by Census Tract



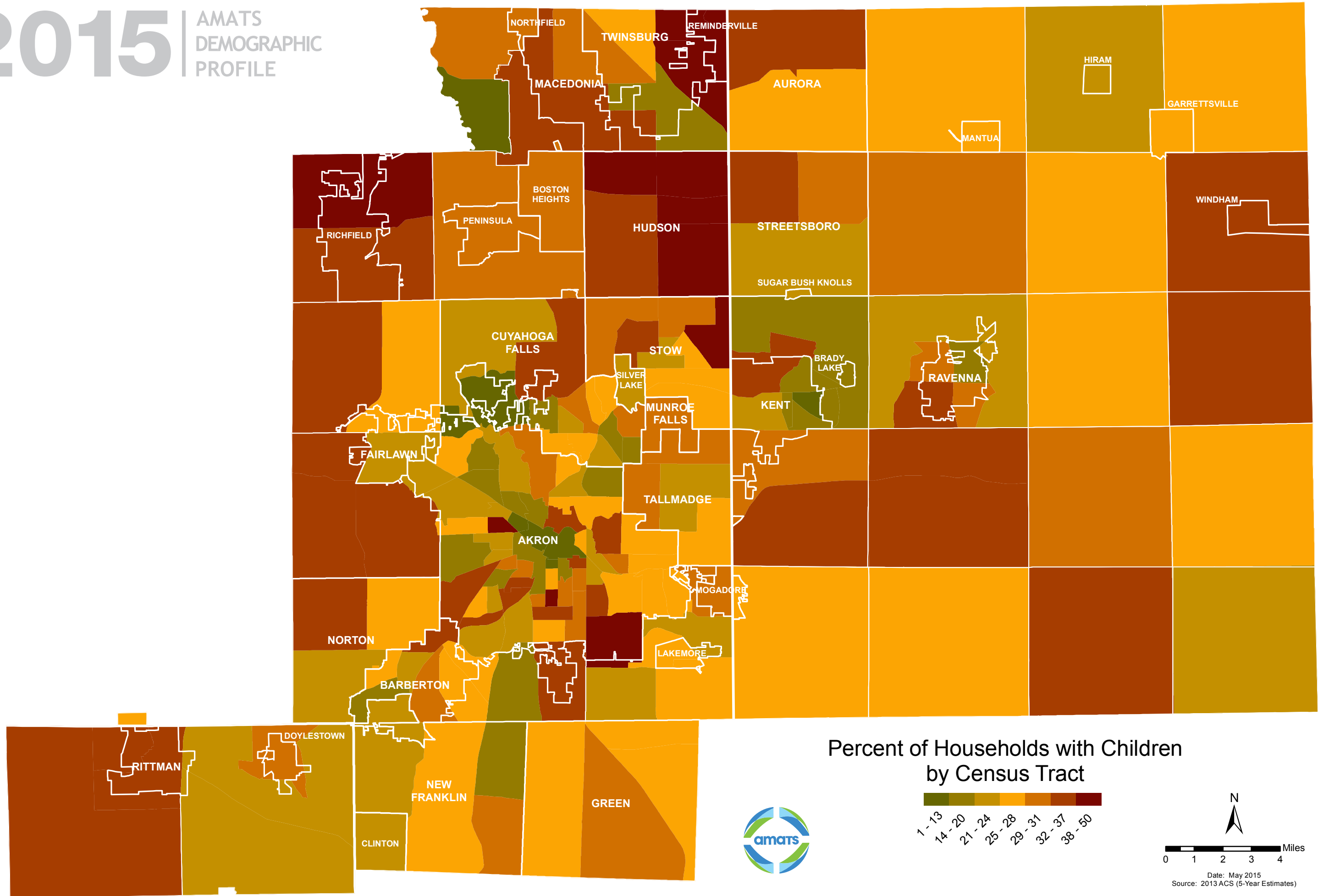

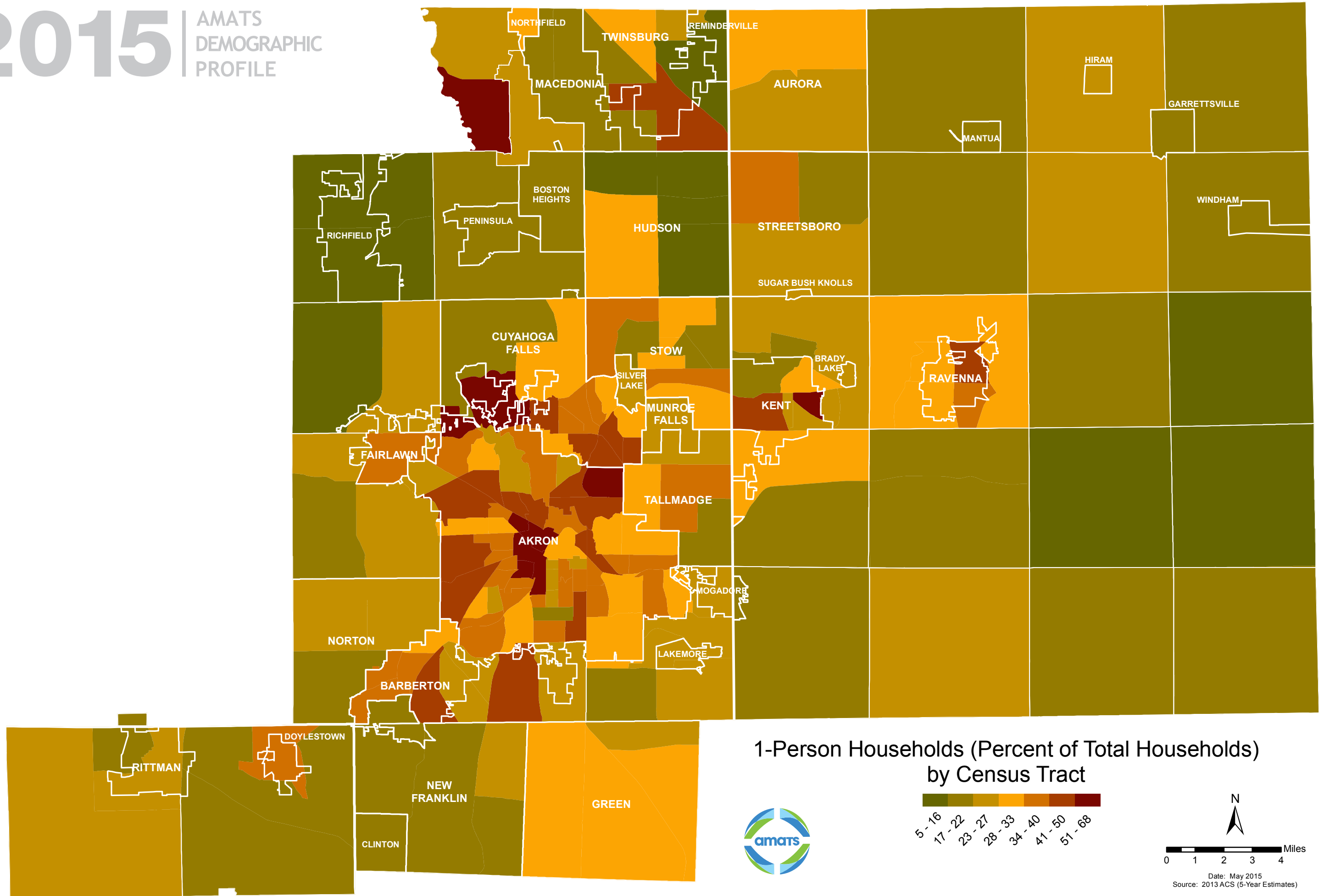


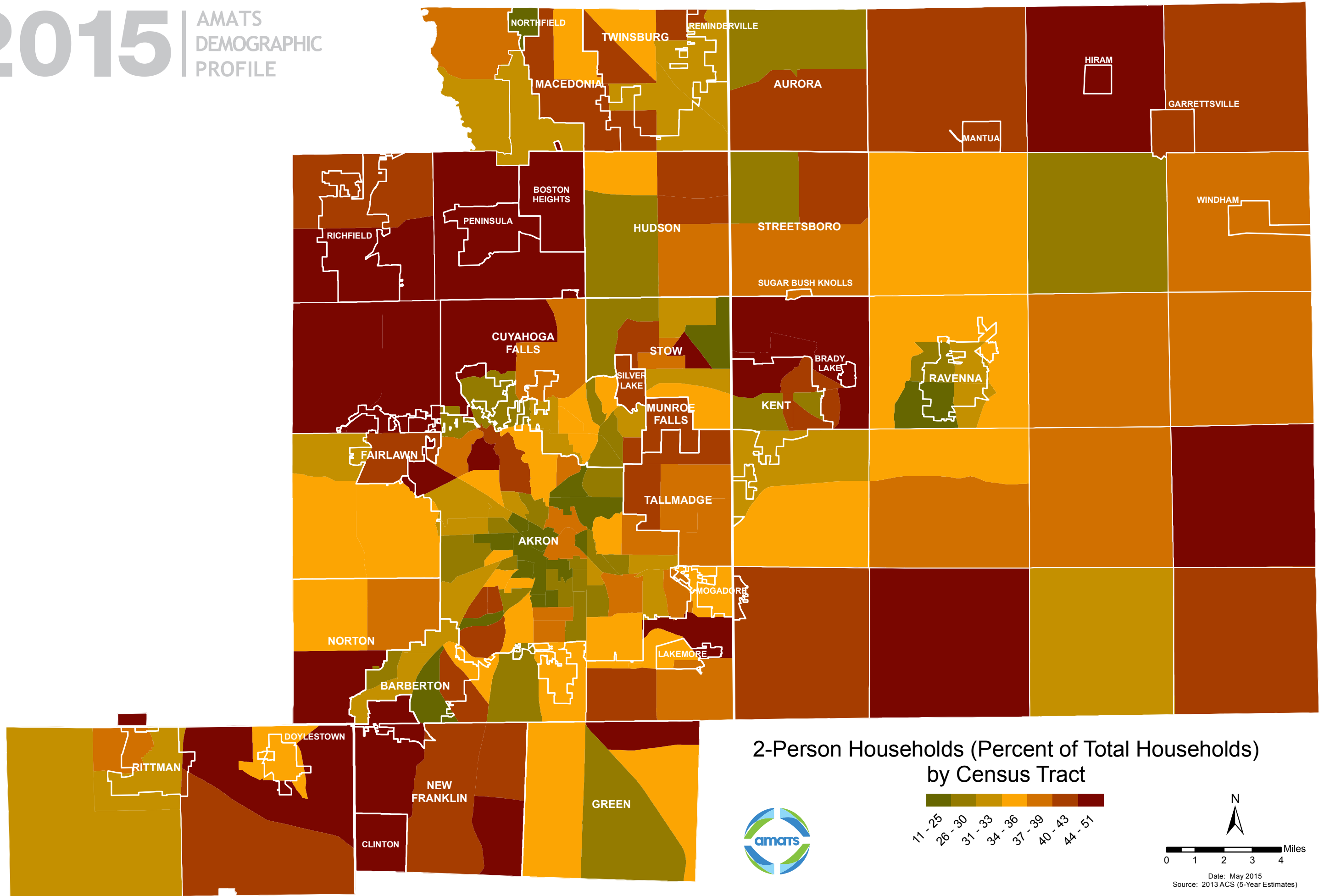
Average Household Size by Census Tract



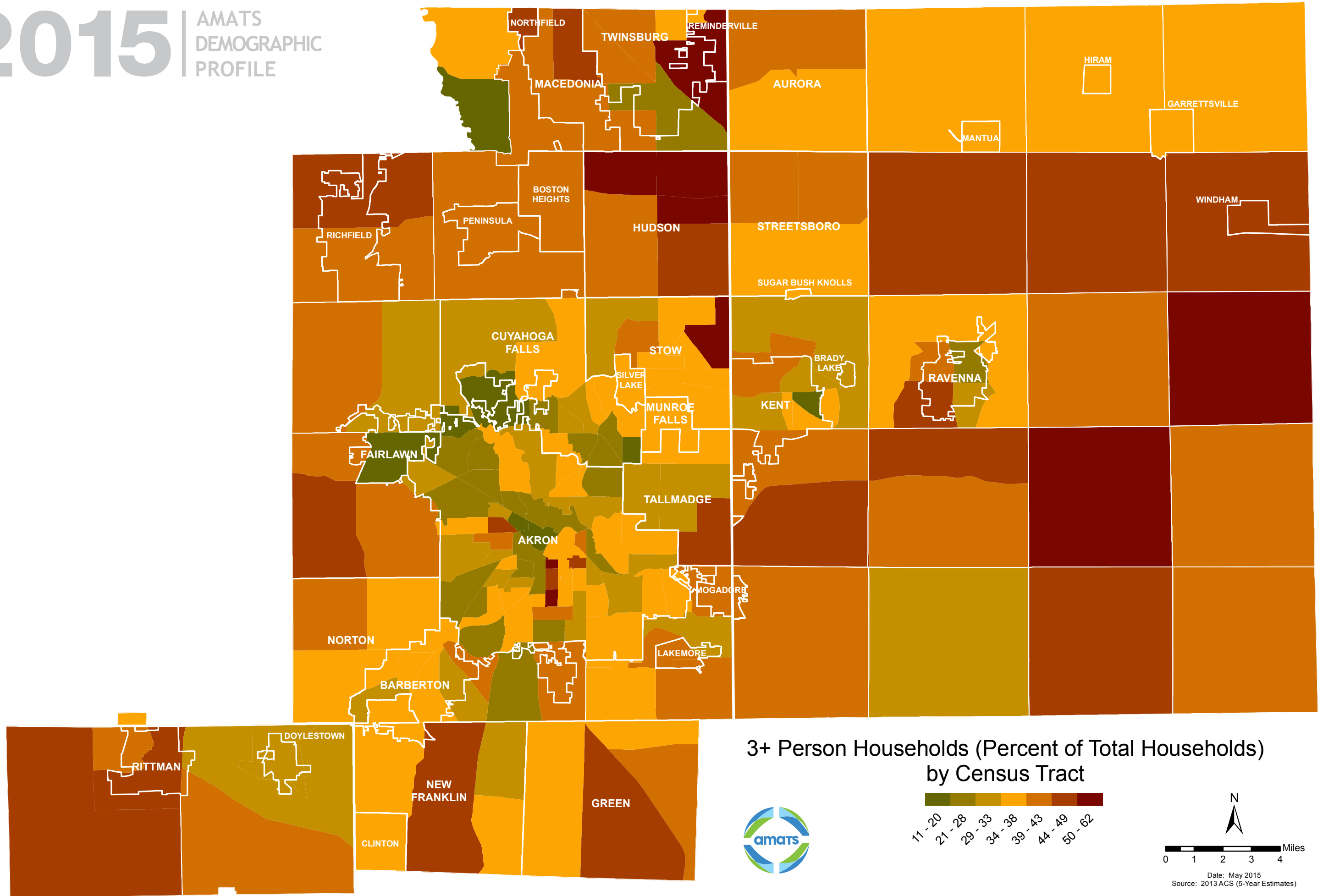

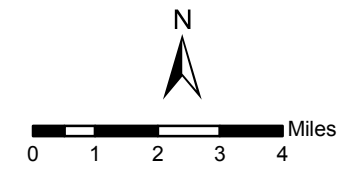
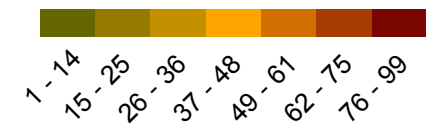
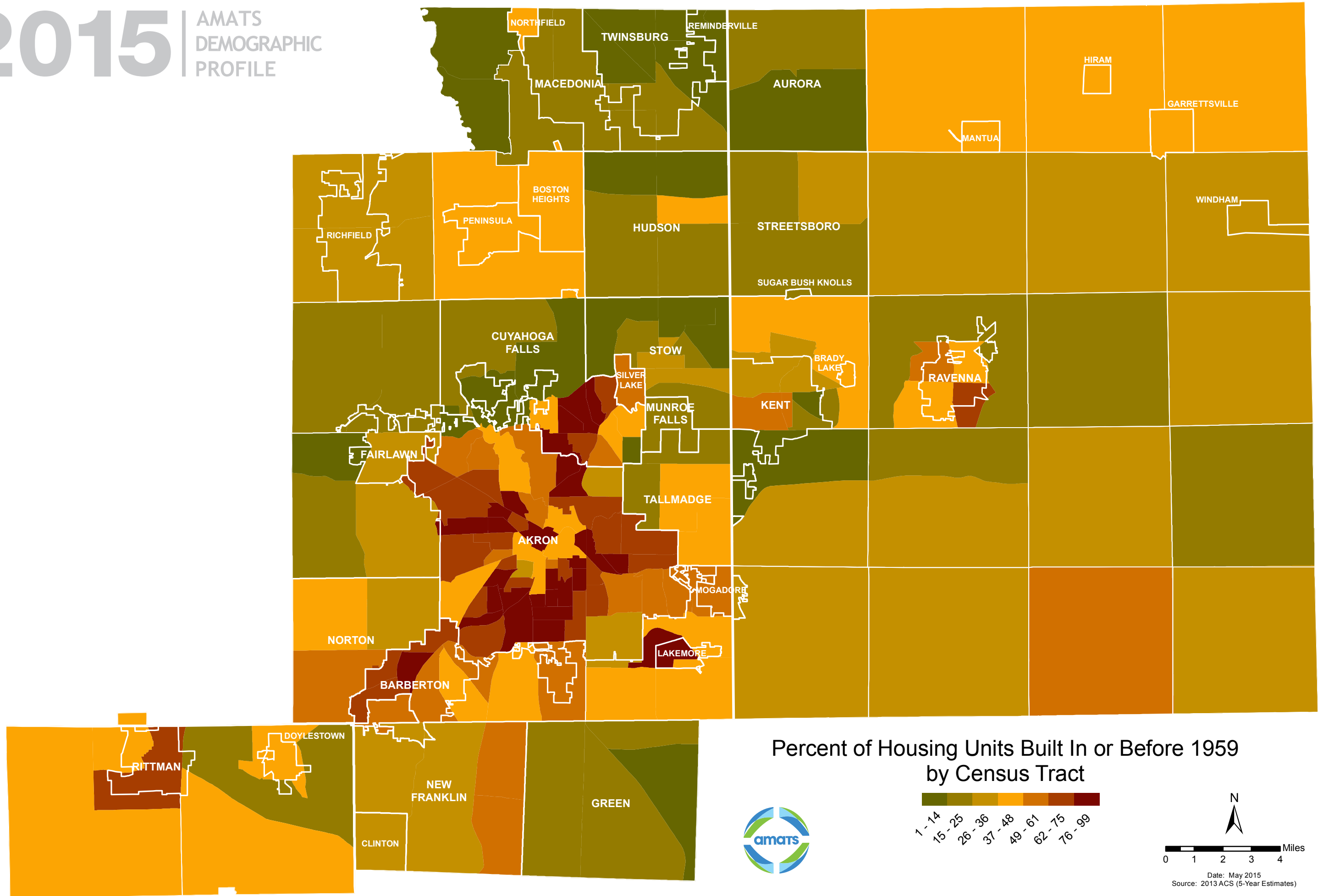


Median Year Housing Built by Census Tract
