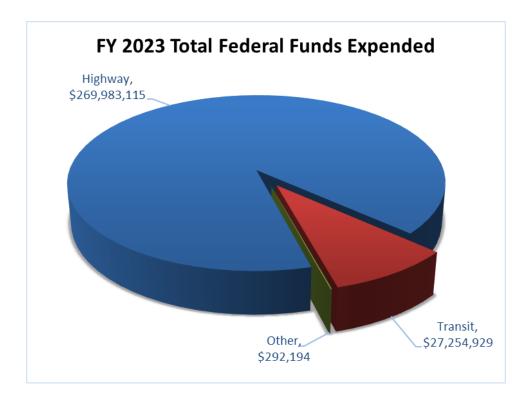
Introduction

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) defines obligation as the federal government's commitment to pay or reimburse an entity for the federal share of a project's eligible cost. Obligation does not necessarily indicate expenditure or project completion; only that the project has been approved by the government for reimbursement.

This report includes the status of all projects listed in the Transportation Improvement Program for FY 2023, which began on July 1, 2022 and ended on June 30, 2023.

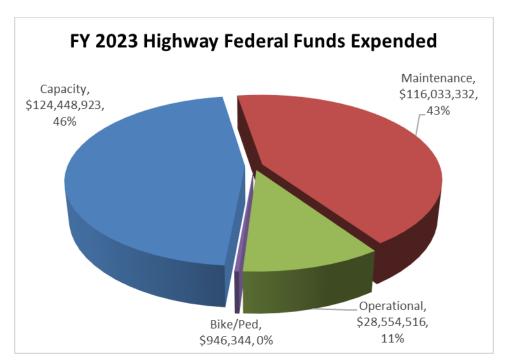
Obligation Report

During FY 2023, \$297.5 million of federal funds was expended in the AMATS area. Of this total, \$270.0 million was for highway projects and \$27.3 million for transit projects. The remaining \$292,194 was expended on the AMATS Air Quality Advocacy Program, the Rideshare Program, and various ODOT-led studies. The following pie chart is a summary of the percentage of total federal expenditures by mode in the TIP for FY 2023.



Highway Projects

There are several different types of highway projects listed in the TIP. These include capacity, operational, maintenance and bike/ped type projects. Capacity projects can include the construction of new roadways and adding new lanes to existing roadways to accommodate larger volumes of traffic. In FY 2023 there were \$124.4 million in capacity type projects scheduled in the TIP. However, this expenditure was all for engineering and right of way for future construction of these projects. Operational projects which improve the flow of traffic by coordinating traffic signals, adding turn lanes, and/or railroad signage improvements accounted for a total of \$28.6 million in expenditures. Maintenance and preservation projects such as resurfacing, reconstruction, or bridge replacements accounted for a total of \$116.0 million. Offroad bikeway and pedestrian projects amounted to \$0.9 million. The following pie charts show the expenditures for each project type by federal funding sources.

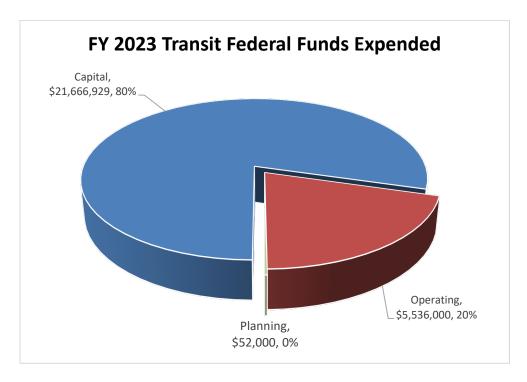


The Highway Project tables, located at the end of this report, are reflective of the various stages of project development that occurred during FY 2023. The tables are divided into projects that encumbered construction funding, were authorized for preliminary engineering or right-of-way, planning studies authorized, or were cancelled or delayed. The tables provide detailed information such as locations and limits, type of work, the amount of federal funds programmed for projects, and remaining federal funds.

Transit Projects

Transit projects are also divided into several different types in the TIP. These include capital, operating and planning type projects. Capital projects include purchasing of equipment, which is typically new buses. In FY 2023, there was \$21.7 million in federal capital expenditures. Federal operating expenditures such as personnel salaries, fuel costs and routine maintenance on buses and facilities accounted for a little over \$5.5 million. Spending on transit agency planning activities such as conducting regional transit planning and measuring of system performance was \$52,000 in federal funds. The following pie chart shows the percentage of expenditures for each project type by federal funding sources.

The Transit Projects table provides project information such as type of project, the amount of federal funds awarded or programmed and the status of the grant or project in FY 2023.



Additional Notes

Negative amounts listed in the tables below reflect project cost adjustments in the years after a project is sold or when unspent funds are released to closing out a project. These negatives were not included in the pie chart totals. Also note that if a project sold in FY 2023 and no funds were released this project is not listed in the tables.

This report reflects the state fiscal year of July 1 to June 30. The Federal Fiscal Year, however, runs from October 1 to September 30. Therefore, there may be some projects obligated after July 1 but before October 1 that are obligated in Federal Fiscal Year 2023. These will be noted in next year's report.
