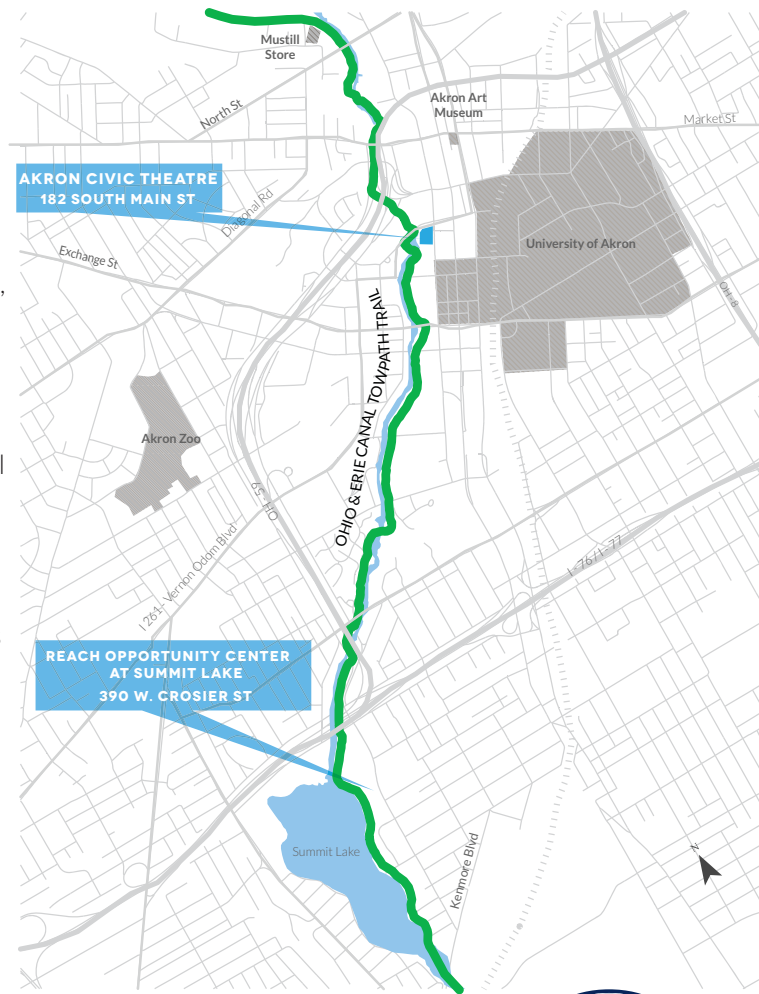

This amazing transportation and recreational trail travels near downtown, adjacent neighborhoods, parks, regional destinations, and more.

The study team from Alta Planning + Design, a leader in bicycle and pedestrian planning, design, and implementation, will gather public input, evaluate ideas for improvements, and present a feasible vision of potential future changes to the areas along and around the trail. In order to make the Towpath Trail more accessible and useful to nearby residents and businesses, some improvements could include traffic calming, pedestrian enhancements, trail signs, street lighting, or connecting bikeways.
